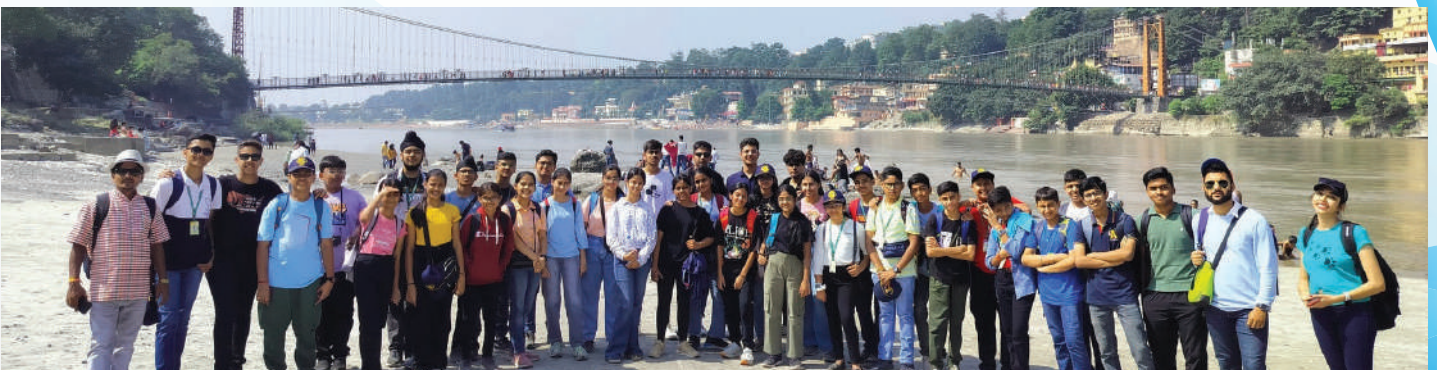
VISIT TO METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT
