

## Mentor's Musings


#### Unveiling Progress Through Unwavering Dreams







#### **TECHNOLOGY – BOON OR BANE?**

Christian Lous Lange once truly said, "Technology is a useful servant but a dangerous master". Technology is the application of scientific principles to the creation of a machine or technology that meets human needs. It has evolved into a crucial component of our existence. #### भण्याचार एक रोग


