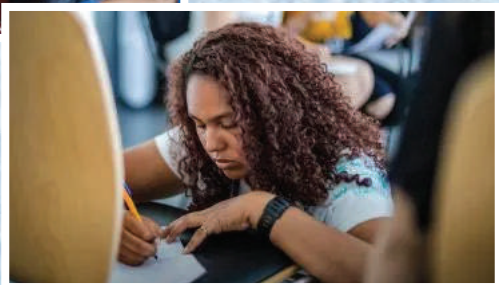

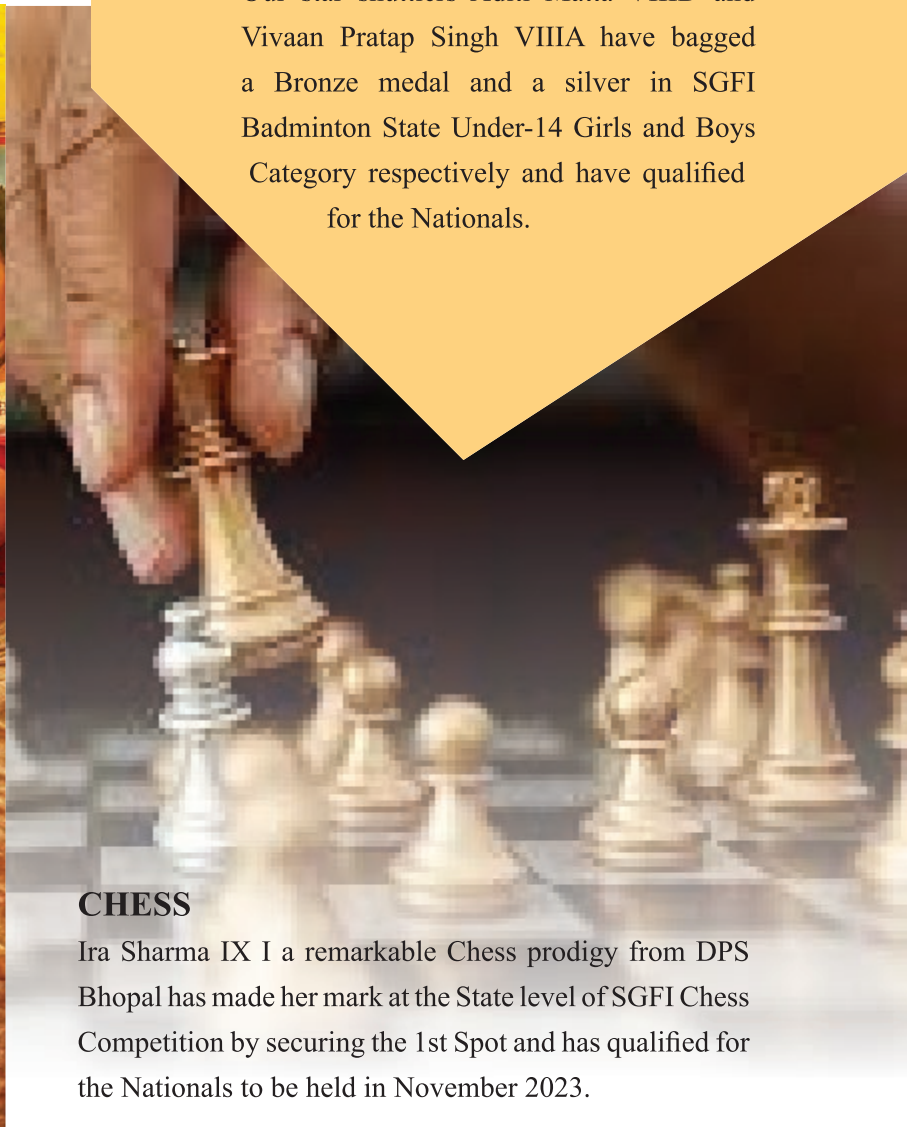

How words are our life. How words are all we have.

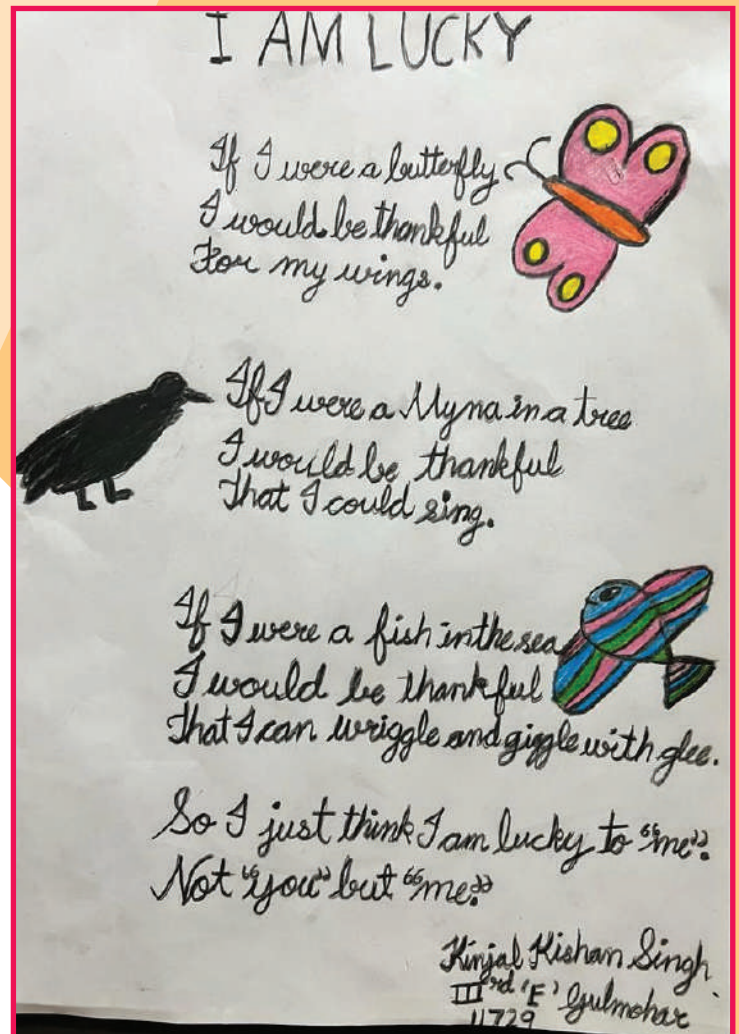
How we are torn apart because of them.

I am told that eyes tell more than words ever can.


